PARADE DETAILS

DATE/TIME:	Saturday, March 19, 2016 Starting @ 11:00 AM and ending at approximately 12:30 PM
PARADE ROUTE:	As in previous years, the Parade will leave the intersection of Elgin St. and Laurier Avenue West at 11:00 am. The parade will proceed westward on Laurier Avenue West to Bank Street and then south on Bank Street to Lansdowne Park. "Tear-down" will be at the Aberdeen Pavilion (Cattle Castle).
OTTAWA FOOD BANK: Volunteers will be collecting cash and food donations along the Parade route; please be generous.	
FORMATION:	Parade entries will form-up on Laurier Avenue Bridge between 8:00 AM and 10:45 AM. Each entry will be advised of their position in the Parade no later than March 10, 2016.
PARKING:	Paid underground parking is available at Ottawa City Hall and area on street parking is also available. Paid underground parking is also available at Lansdowne Park. The entrance is off Bank Street on your right hand side under TD Place.
SHUTTLE SERVICE: Shuttle buses will operate between Lansdowne Park and Ottawa City Hall starting at 8:30 am
